## Course Description

Students will learn how to marzipan, ice and decorate a celebration cake.

1. Prepare, jam, marzipan fruit cake, make rose cones.
2. Unwired rose petals, unwired rose leaves.
3. Ice, marzipan cake, and board.
4. Make royal icing, cake onto cake board, fill and seal to board.
5. Make icing bags, practice piping.
6. Pipe cake, mark out for frills.
7. Dust roses and leaves.
8. Make bows for frills.
9. Pipe writing, roses and leaves onto cake.

## Teaching/learning methods used

Discussion and demonstration.
