

Year 10 & 11 - Product Design Curriculum Plan

<p><u>Year 11</u></p> <p>Much of the second year of the course is dedicated to manufacturing the outcome of the controlled assessment. You will manufacture this final piece in time to then gather consumer opinions, test the piece against the brief and specification, and evaluate the result. As in year 10, the controlled assessment will be delivered alongside theory lessons and focused practical tasks. The controlled assessment will complete leaving time to focus lessons solely on preparing for the final exam.</p> <p>You will receive pre-release material from the exam board which will give you an insight exam design topic, allowing you to prepare for the design section of the exam which counts for 25% of the paper mark. Coverage of the rest of the exam topics will be through lesson schemes of work. Past papers will be used so that you can practice and get a feel for the examination.</p>	<p>Controlled assessment – this is continued from year 10.</p> <p>Mock exam – as with the mock exam in year 10.</p> <p>Terminal Exam – this is your final exam in the summer term and will count to 40% of your final grade.</p>
