

## Year 7 French Curriculum Plan

Topics covered	Assessments
<p><b><u>Unit 1 C'est Parti</u></b>  <b>Context</b> Topics include basic greetings, the alphabet, classroom objects and numbers 1-20, giving your age, saying the date, when your birthday is and basic classroom instructions.</p> <p><b><u>Unit 2 En Famille</u></b>  <b>Context</b> Pupils will talk and understand information about immediate family, numbers 30-69 and describe the family. Pupils will describe themselves, pets, colours and classroom furniture using the Present tense.</p> <p><b><u>Unit 3 Chez Moi</u></b>  <b>Context</b> The geography of France, saying where you live and talking about your house and room are covered. Basic hobbies and household tasks are discussed. Pupils use dictionary skills and learn about regular -er verbs. They tell the time and find out more rules for pronouncing French.</p> <p><b><u>Unit 4 Comme d'habitude</u></b>  <b>Context</b> Places in town, directions and arranging to meet, more hobbies and home activities are learnt. Pupils will write a letter. The Present tense of common regular and irregular verbs will be taught. Pupils express simple opinions, ask questions and read harder texts using dictionary skills.</p> <p><b><u>Unit 5 Une journée</u></b>  <b>Context</b> Pupils will understand and discuss school subjects, their teachers, the school timetable and day. They will give telephone numbers and describe their daily routine. They will do more on negatives, quantifiers, the 24 hour clock and numbers 70-100. They will learn reflexive verbs and improve their pronunciation and learn spelling rules.</p> <p><b><u>Unit 6 Comment tu t'amuses?</u></b>  <b>Context</b> Pupils will describe leisure activities, sports, music and write a letter about their hobbies. They will understand and use the infinitive after aimer and other verbs, adverbs of time and frequency as well as combining sentences with conjunctions in their work.</p>	<p>Assessments will take place at the end of most units</p> <p>Autumn Term</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1.
