

Year 9 Spanish Curriculum Plan

Topics covered	Assessments
<p>Pupils build on their first year of Spanish with a range of topics and use two to three tenses to discuss the following :</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Presentations, describing friends, nationalities, describing the town and doing an extended interview 2. TV programmes, films, invitations, making excuses, saying what someone else likes and dislikes 3. Describing past holidays, what you did, give opinions, give a presentation about holidays and learn more about Spanish-speaking countries 4. Clothes, school uniform, choosing clothes, talking about a trip to Argentina and different types of shop 5. Mealtimes, shopping for food, eating at a restaurant, talking about a past meal and use the preterite of different verbs 6.
