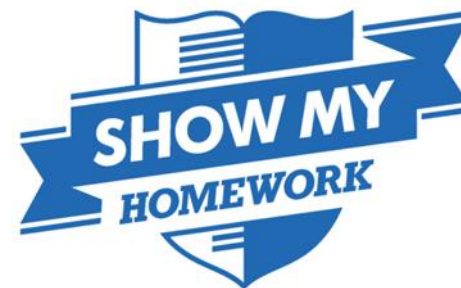

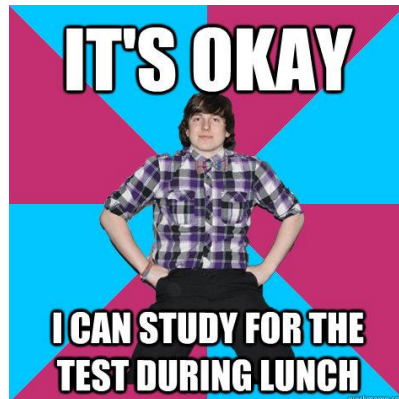

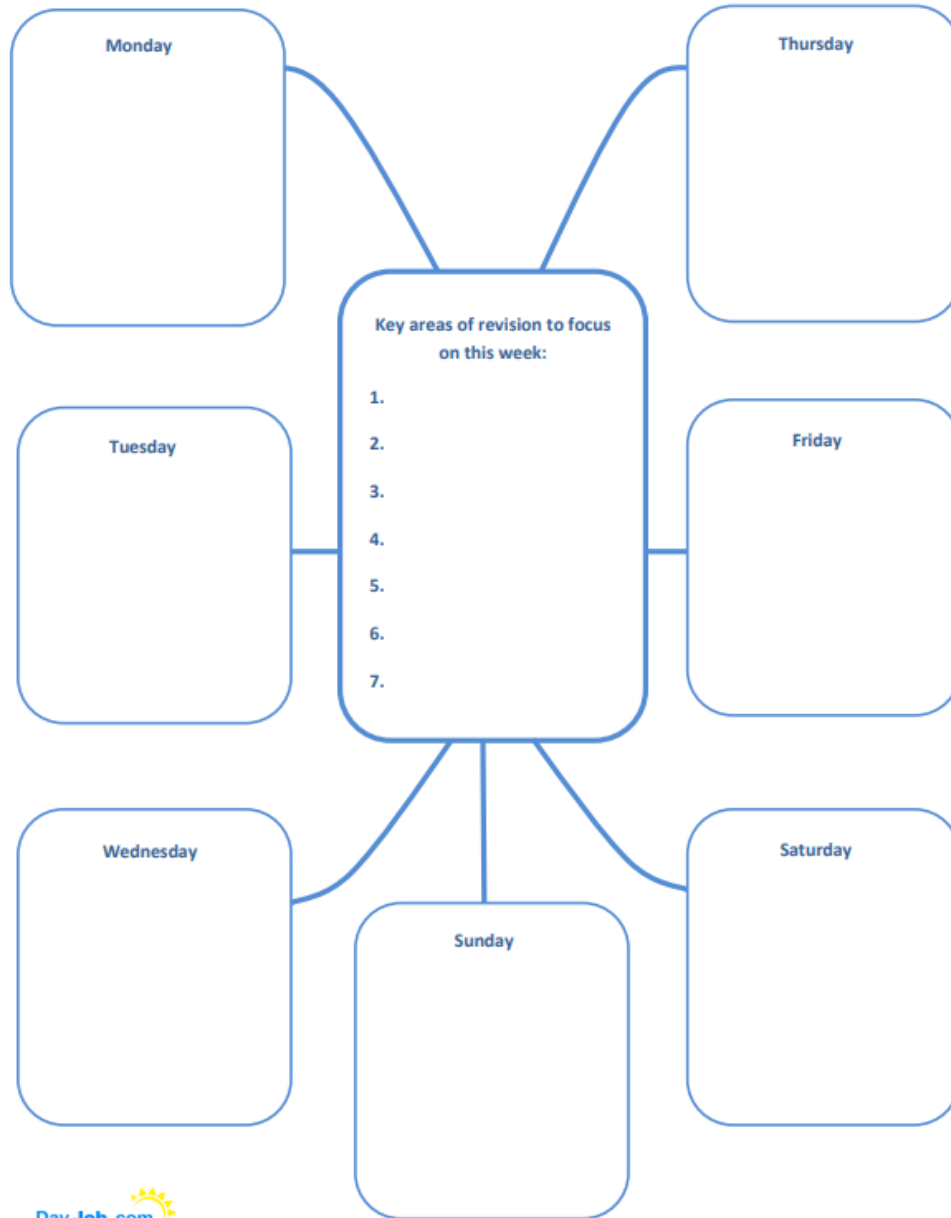

Top Tips – Little and Often

- Short bursts are most effective **30 to 40 minutes**, then take a break of 5 – 10 minutes. Encourage your child to go outside
- Between 4 and 6 hours a day
- Ensure your child has a quiet space to revise
- Eating properly and getting plenty of sleep is key
- If your child is stuck, encourage them to ask their teachers to go through it again.



More Top Tips

- Break subjects down into topics – not just maths, but quadratic equations!
- Start with topics that you find the most tricky to allow you time to revisit
- Colour code your subjects
- Have a day off a week. Your child will still be processing and reflecting on their revision
- Help your child to work out when they concentrate best – it may not be first thing in the morning!

Be flexible

- Sometimes your child won't be able to stick rigidly to their timetable
- Be supportive if circumstances change
- Encourage your child to assess their progress weekly and adjust their timetable accordingly.
