Further Information

Art Studio Time (JMc) - An opportunity for students to work independently, get focused, share ideas with support from peers and teacher.

ARTYCDAH (HCR) - Arts Award "Drop-in" with skills based workshops, general art and self-guided projects.

Bell Ringing Club (WS) - Learn how to ring methods on hand-bells (Campanology). We also ring tunes for the Christmas Carol service.

Book and Paper Craft Club (DH)

All year groups are welcome on Wednesdays from 3.05 – 4.15pm in the Library. Students will use a variety of techniques using damaged / old books and paper.

Duke of Edinburgh (GB)

For all students who have signed up for the Bronze Award.

Food Club Lunchtime (LJ) - Learn cake decorating skills, modelling, piping sugar flowers. Depending on the time of year will make cakes, biscuits for charity sales for example children in need. There is a small charge of £3 this term to cover the materials but the students take home what they make!

Food Club After College (LJ) – There is a charge of £4.50 per session. Students bring the ingredients for their dishes and take home their food.

Illustration Club (DH)

All year groups are welcome on Mondays from 3.05 – 4.15pm in the Library. Students can choose to draw the "Object of the Week" or find inspiration online or in books to draw what stimulates them. Students should bring their own equipment eg colouring pens and pencils.

Learn to Play... (HJ) - Students have the opportunity to learn and play keyboard, ukulele or guitar and practice with Music Prefects.

Lower School Choir (RG) - Music Mobile (room 20). Students sing a range of popular songs and have the chance of performing on a trip at the end of the year.

Philosophy and Debate Club (CS) - We discuss a wide range of topics and encourage students to run their own sessions on topics that they are enthusiastic about. We also run trips to a local primary school to educate Y6 students about Philosophical issues and we have a link with Lucy Frazer MP who runs a competition which sees two of our Y11 students going to Parliament for a debate.

School of Rock and Pop (Cambridge Music)

All year groups are welcome on Tuesdays at 3.15pm in Music 1. You learn to play as part of a band and develop performance technique and stage presence, as well as arranging and composing songs – both on your own and with others. Students are supported by established musicians and songwriters. All abilities including complete beginners welcome. £30 a term.

STEM Club (LA) - We will be creating a range of different things from cardboard chairs and cardboard boats before we take on the Fluid Power Challenge. We will be experimenting with hydraulics and pneumatics to lift certain objects.

Warhammer Club (AFC) - Anyone is welcome to come along and watch games being played. Currently we have students playing Warhammer 40K, Yu Gi Oh and Magic the Gathering. There is no cost involved, but anyone looking to get into any of these games will need to supply their own models, cards etc. and these can get expensive.
